### SPORTS PREMIUM SCHOOL POLICY

At Wentworth C of E Junior and Infant School we believe PE & Sport plays a critical role in educating the whole child. PE contributes directly to development of physical competence and fitness. It also helps children to make informed choices and understand the value of leading a physically active lifestyle.

#### SPORT PREMIUM MONEY ALLOCATION

We have welcomed the Government's announcement in June 2013 to provide additional funding for 2 years to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. We are committed to using this resource in developing high quality PE lessons, alongside greater opportunities for sporting competitions and clubs for all our young people.

**Sport Premium Grant: £8925 for each year – 2013/14 + 2014/15**

*'Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this' (DfE June 2013).*

So our PE funding has been used in the following ways:

- To fund two PE specialists, via Wath Comprehensive school. These are joint appointments, along with other schools in our Learning Community. Both PE specialists work in school for half a day each week. They deliver high quality PE lessons and staff work alongside them for professional development. They also provide support for staff with planning PE lessons. In addition, the PE specialists organise inter-school events that children participate in and partnership tournaments that link to Rotherham wide finals

- To release our PE subject leader to attend Learning Community meetings for subject leaders – supply cover costs
- To subsidise transport costs for children attending sporting events, e.g English Institute of Sport
- To purchase new equipment for children to use during break-times to encourage more children to participate in physical activity.

## **AIMS OF THE SUPPORT**

### **To provide High Quality Physical Education: Raising standards of all our children in Physical education**

- Regular specialist support from qualified PE teachers or qualified sports coaches working with primary teachers to achieve high quality teaching and learning in lessons.
- Support in monitoring and evaluating the progress of pupils through assessment.
- CPD opportunities for teachers in PE & Sport.
- Developing opportunity for student leadership programmes
- Inclusive competitive sports opportunities
- Organised competitions at local/borough level
