What we are doing:

The new School Council are looking at healthy snacks and packed lunches that the children bring to school and will help to write a new Healthy School Policy.

What we are doing:

A staff member has taken on the role of coordinating ‘Wentworth Extra’ activities to take place both at lunchtime and after school. The children have been voting for their preferred activities alongside staff searching to enhance the provision in immersive and imaginative ways. The website has a Wentworth Extra section where parents and children can add their ideas.

You said “continue to offer support for home learning”

What we are doing:

A change in the style of home learning is being trialled with each class having a learning project for the children to work through in their own individual way. It is hoped that this will engage children at home where they have ownership of how they want to present their learning with opportunity to share it with others in the Fabulous Finish.
