Sunshine Value

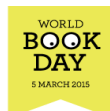

World Book Day

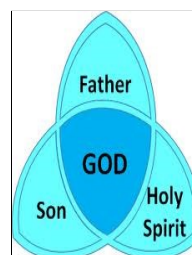


World Book Day is a fabulous event that takes place in many schools across the country. It is a great way for us to promote reading and enjoyment around books in our own school.
