- ▶ Always ask your parents permission when using the internet!
- ▶ There might be unsafe and or inappropriate things online, your parents will try to keep you safe and away from this.
- ▶ If you don't tell them, they can't help you!

- ▶ Don't give away personal information. You should never give out your name, address or phone number to anyone online or to strangers!

- ▶ They can report this and sort it for you!

- ▶ Make sure your accounts are private and that you have parents permission.

SIENNA'S TOP TIP

- ▶ Always make sure your social media accounts are set to PRIVATE.
- ▶ This means that your profile will be safe from strangers and there is less danger.
- ▶ Also, be careful not to click on any adverts that pop up on your screen. They may be dangerous!

RUBY'S TOP TIP

- ▶ There are age restrictions on Social Media to keep you safe. There might be inappropriate pictures/videos/messages. There is also the chance that strangers may contact you.
- ▶ Whatsapp – 16
- ▶ Youtube – 13 (with parents permission – if not 18)
- ▶ Twitter, Spotify, Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat – 13
- ▶ This is because Whatsapp and Spotify may have inappropriate messages/songs on it and you can contact people you don't know.
- ▶ You should try not to use your full name on any accounts.

JACK'S TOP TIP

- ▶ If anyone sends you any hurtful/inappropriate messages to you online, report them as soon as possible!
- ▶ You must also tell your parents!
- ▶ If you don't report these, it may continue and you will get more and more upset.
